Pageant Website Report for 2010

Pageant Website size and structure

The overall website structure has remained the same since 2004, but its size has steadily increased. About 30 pages are kept constantly up-to-date, many older pages are retained as an archive of Pageant's activities, and there is an occasional cull of obviously redundant pages.



Search results and site ranking


Google is the acknowledged market leader amongst search engines, so we don't now check other search engines. In searches using 'gambia' 'education' and 'charity', our home page has dropped from first place to fourth and our links page is in 20th place. Google PageRank has remained at 4 for more than two years. (PageRank is a rating system used by Google to show how important they think a page is. The minimum is 0 and maximum 10, with a logarithmic scale.)

Traffic to the site

The graph below shows that there is considerable month-to-month variation in traffic to our website, but there is an underlying downward trend over the last two or three years.



Overall usage has continued to fall since a peak in 2008. This seems to mirror economic conditions in the UK, with fewer people having spare cash for charities, and therefore less interest in charity websites. In December 2010, it was reported that overall donations to UK charities have declined by 11% over the preceding year. Smaller charities have suffered more than larger ones, with a fall in donations of around 20%. However, Pageant's donations have not shown such a reduction, indicating that our core support remains firm even though casual viewing of our website may have fallen.

Top 20 Pages Viewed

The following is a list of the top 20 pages viewed during 2010. For comparison, we show the number of views during 2009 and the percentage change. Topical stories and news pages obviously attract fewer views as they get out of date. Views of older news pages were down by about 30%, whereas views of general pages, which are constantly updated, were down by around 15 to 20%. There was a drop in views of our Sponsorship pages, but actual sponsorship hasn't fallen. Views of our Ethical Gifts pages increased, and sales of gift tokens were up by 12.5% over last year. The Gifts Pages have recently been revised and improved, so we hope that more people will purchase Pageant Ethical Gifts in 2011. The increased views of the 2007 IceCold page is a puzzle, but in most cases users didn't go on to other pages on our site, so these could be people searching for something else.
