
The overall structure of the site has remained the same since 2004. We still aim to comply as closely as possible with the W3C specifications on accessibility. Growth of the site during 2006 brought us close to our web hosting limit of 100Mb, so video clips and selected pictures were moved to an auxiliary site. Further growth in 2007 brought us close to the limit again. We therefore moved to a new hosting service, giving us 2Gb at **a lower annual cost**. The move was accomplished without break of service, and totally invisible to users. We have ample room for growth, and all videos and pictures have been brought back to the main site.

Search results and site ranking

The Google search engine still has the major share of all search engine usage – around 56% globally, and probably bigger in the UK – so there is little point in considering other search engines. The Pageant home page still has a Google PageRank of 4/10, and our home page is still listed at No 1 using search terms 'gambia' 'education' and 'charity', with our links page still at No 2. It is also amazing how often a Pageant page is in the top 10 when searching for information about The Gambia.

Traffic to the site

The cumulative graph below shows that despite fluctuations, there has been an underlying steady increase in traffic of about 20% from 2006 to 2007. Cumulative graphs, updated monthly, are on the website – link on the members page.

Recent Activities

Pageant has once again benefitted from the help of teams taking part in the Plymouth-Banjul Challenge. Previously in the 2006 Challenge, Shap Ahoy and Super Trooper together raised nearly £9000, and in 2007 Ibrakeforcake, Desert Mice, First to the Bar and the IceCold teams together raised about £9600. Pageant offers a web page hosting service in return for this help, which provides each team with a page where they can promote their fundraising activities, and we then update this daily during the challenge using reports sent back by email, text message etc. Finally we can turn the teams' challenge diaries and photos into a permanent record of their acheivements. Transplant Titans have recently completed the 2008 Challenge, raising a substantial sum for Pageant. They report that other teams were very

impressed by their web page, so perhaps the word will spread, and we will have some mutually beneficial relationships with more teams next year.

Statistics

Due to an oversight, I didn't retrieve detailed statistics from our old hosting service for the period up to 25 October 2007. However, I do have detailed statistics for the last two months of 2007, and have added in January 2008 to get a picture of the top pages on our site for a three month period. It is quite striking how the second most popular page is that for Transplant Titans.

We launched the News Blog (pageant-news.blogspot.com) in July 2006.
